

In the event of a discrepancy between the transcript and the recorded audio statement on CD, the CD should be used as the most accurate account of the statement.

The interview with Detective [redacted] was completed at approximately 10:00 a.m.

At approximately 12:00 p.m., Detective [redacted] and Detective [redacted] arrived at the Saint Louis Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a previously scheduled meeting with [redacted]. After arriving at the front parking lot, detectives noticed a large media presence across the street from the building. Their attention was directed toward the front of the building.

At the front entrance to the building, detectives were contacted by [redacted] and [redacted] appeared uncomfortable by the media presence, immediately departed the conversation and sat inside [redacted] vehicle on the parking lot. [redacted] explained to detectives that [redacted] did not wish to provide a statement at that time because there had been death threats about the situation. [redacted] explained [redacted] would only provide a witness statement if [redacted] was compelled to by a Grand Jury.

This concluded the conversation with [redacted] and [redacted] departed the parking lot.

Detective [redacted] updated her Federal Bureau of Investigation liaison, Analyst [redacted] of Detective [redacted] s progress regarding [redacted]. Detective [redacted] also relayed subpoena information pertaining to subpoenas already presented to the grand jury by Detective [redacted] on Tuesday, August 12, 2014 regarding news coverage of the shooting including: KMOV, KSDK, Fox News Network, Turner Broadcast System, Saint Louis Post Dispatch, Fox 2 News and NBC Universal. Each of these organizations had previously been identified as having provided witness coverage of the incident.

Detective [redacted] and Detective [redacted] identified an individual claiming to be an eyewitness of the incident. The individual, [redacted] had engaged in a [redacted] Instant Message (IM) chat with [redacted] in which he described his alleged eyewitness account of the incident. An unknown individual, identified with the Twitter handle of [redacted] posted a screenshot of this IM chat and posted it to a [redacted] feed for witnesses. A subsequent computer investigation revealed [redacted] was the same individual who appeared to be the account holder of the [redacted] account for [redacted]. Notification of this information, including a digital copy of the information, was made by Detective [redacted] to Detective [redacted].

Detective [redacted] was advised by Detective [redacted] that information was being circulated regarding P.O. Darren Wilson's Facebook page. The information claimed P.O. Darren Wilson had uploaded details of the incident to his Facebook page. P.O. Darren Wilson had previously provided Detective [redacted] with voluntary

written consent for his Facebook account to be accessed and searched. Detective _____ relayed this information to Detective _____ who accessed the account, digitally recorded the account's contents, produced a digital copy of the account's contents, and packaged this digital copy of P.O. Darren Wilson's Facebook account, which she placed into evidence at the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit.

P.O. Darren Wilson's Facebook account displayed a Profile Name of "Darren Wilson" and a username of _____

Detective _____ subsequently executed the court order by sending it to Sprint on August 20, 2014.

At approximately 4:30 p.m., Detective _____ contacted Paramedic _____ by phone and asked him if he had any contact with P.O. Darren Wilson on scene or afterwards. This was based on a comment made by Lieutenant Colonel _____ during his interview, in which he thought a Christian Hospital EMS Paramedic washed the blood off P.O. Darren Wilson's hands and arms. Paramedic _____ said he and his partner,

Paramedic [redacted] were dispatched to the scene on Canfield Drive. When they arrived, P.O. Darren Wilson was not at the scene, and they proceeded to a staging area.

This concluded the conversation with Paramedic [redacted]

At approximately 4:35 p.m., Detective [redacted] contacted Paramedic [redacted] of Christian Hospital EMS by phone. He said he and his partner, Paramedic [redacted] were operating Christian Hospital Ambulance [redacted] on August 9, 2014. They were requested to respond to the Ferguson Police Department and check on P.O. Darren Wilson. When they arrived, P.O. Darren Wilson was in a room with another officer. P.O. Darren Wilson told them he was refusing medical treatment. [redacted] said he and [redacted] left the Police Department. He said they had no physical contact with P.O. Darren Wilson.

This concluded the conversation with Paramedic [redacted]

At approximately 5:00 p.m., Detective [redacted] contacted Paramedic [redacted] by phone. He said after they left the sick case at [redacted] Glenark Drive, they were flagged down by an officer on Canfield Drive to assist the shooting victim. He said he did not see P.O. Darren Wilson at the scene.

This concluded the conversation with Paramedic [redacted]

After contacting all three sets of paramedics who had involvement with this incident, it was determined none of them assisted P.O. Darren Wilson in washing the blood off his hand and arms.

Detective [redacted] received the Post-Mortem Examination Report of Brown from the Saint Louis County Medical Examiner's Office. The report, completed by Doctor [redacted] indicated the cause of death was due to gunshot wounds of the head and chest, and the manner of death was homicide. Also attached was a Saint Louis University Toxicology Laboratory Report which indicated Brown tested positive for cannabinoids. Details of both the examination and the toxicology report can be viewed under Saint Louis County Medical Examiner's Office Report Number 14-5143.

He stated Brown first approached him and his co-worker outside an apartment as they were working. _____ said Brown approached them and Brown stated he was "getting a bad vibe" from them. _____ said Brown asked them if they were mad at something. _____ said his co-worker, in an effort to ease apparent tension in the moment, joked that their boss had shorted him on his last paycheck.

_____ stated his co-worker made mention of Brown's socks which had the image of marijuana leaves on them. _____ said Brown responded by stating, "Ain't nothing wrong with a little bud. You gotta try everything once so you know what you like." _____ said during the conversation, Brown acted, "like he was on something." _____ said Brown was talking about Jesus and at one point had raised his arms and, with clenched fists, shook them at the sky.

_____ went on to mention how stressed he had been and talked about losing his job after taking days off to deal with the stress of the incident.

The following information documents the Saint Louis County Police Department's investigative activities on Saturday, August 23, 2014.

At approximately 4:50 p.m., Detective _____ received a call from the Saint Louis County Police Department's Bureau of Communications, who indicated they were speaking with an anonymous caller who had information regarding the incident. Detective _____ was connected with the anonymous caller who sounded as though it was the voice of a 20-30 year old white male.

The male refused to identify himself but said he acquired information from an unknown source that detectives had approached a middle aged black male business owner with a request for business video surveillance from August 9, 2014. The business owner told detectives he did not have video, but told the anonymous caller's source that he in fact did have video. He told the source he lied to detectives because he did not want to appear to be a "sell-out". Detective _____ asked the anonymous caller if he could identify the business owner by a name, which he said he could not. He was asked if he could supply the business name, address, description, etc., to which the anonymous caller only said it was a medium sized, single story, business. He could provide no address but said the business was in the area of West Florissant Avenue near Canfield Drive. The caller would provide no additional details to Detective _____ and the conversation was concluded.

Detective _____ requested from the Saint Louis County Police Department's Bureau of Communications that the audio of the phone call be transferred to a CD for later retrieval.

The following information documents the Saint Louis County Police Department's investigative activities on Monday, August 25, 2014.

At approximately 9:00 a.m., Detective _____ contacted BarnesCare via telephone at _____ and requested P.O. Darren Wilson's toxicology results. Detective _____ was advised BarnesCare could only release the information to a representative from the Ferguson Police Department.

A short time later, Detective [redacted] was contacted via telephone by Human Resources Manager [redacted] of the City of Ferguson. [redacted] said he received the urine analysis toxicology results of P.O. Darren Wilson from BarnesCare. He stated he would fax the results to Detective [redacted]. Moments later, Detective [redacted] received the results via fax to the Saint Louis County Police Department's Division of Criminal Investigation. Detective [redacted] reviewed the results and observed they were as follows:

An attached alcohol screening with a time stamp of 3:56 p.m. indicated the results showed .000.

Detective [redacted] seized the results as evidence and forwarded them to the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit for storage. For more information, reference should be made to the seized toxicology results.

At approximately 9:30 a.m., Detective [redacted] arrived at the Saint Louis County Police Department's Bureau of Communications and contacted 911 Coordinator [redacted]. Detective [redacted] was given four CD's containing Riot A radio traffic (526 audio files), Supervisor phone position S1 (139 audio files), Supervisor phone position S2 (127 audio files) and Point to Point radio traffic (259 audio files). Detective [redacted] later listened to the CD containing audio of radio traffic from Riot A, Point to Point, and telephone conversations for positions Supervisor 1 and Supervisor 2, which had previously been seized. No additional information relevant to the incident was discovered.

The CDs and associated request were seized, packaged as evidence, and released to the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit.

Full details of the transmissions can be heard on the associated CDs.

Detective [redacted] was also given a copy of a digital request made by Detective [redacted]. The request was for a telephone call received by the Saint Louis County Police Department's Bureau of Communications regarding a telephone tip that came in via Position T3 on August 23, 2014 between approximately 4:41 p.m. and 4:45 p.m. This phone call was transferred to Detective [redacted] and the contents of the phone call were previously documented on Saturday, August 23, 2014.

The CD consisted of three audio files detailing the single call.

The CD and associated request were seized, packaged as evidence, and released to the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit.

Full details of the transmissions can be heard on the associated CD.

This concluded the investigation at the Bureau of Communications.

At approximately 10:40 a.m., Detective [redacted] placed a phone call to:

after [redacted] had identified him as a witness.

[redacted] answered the phone and Detective [redacted] identified himself. [redacted] asked if Detective [redacted] could call back in a couple of hours. Detective [redacted] told him he would do so and the conversation was concluded.

Several hours later, at approximately 1:40 p.m., Detective [redacted] spoke with [redacted] by phone.

[redacted] was asked if he witnessed the incident on Canfield Drive, and he indicated he did not. He was told a journalist, identified as [redacted] provided information saying [redacted] was a source and witnessed the shooting. [redacted] said [redacted] misunderstood him. [redacted] said he told the journalist he heard from several people what took place and he was relaying that information.

[redacted] was asked if he would be willing to meet with Detective [redacted] to discuss the information he had been provided. [redacted] said he did not want to meet, because he was in fear of his safety.

This conversation was concluded.

At approximately 11:00 a.m., Detective [redacted] provided Detective [redacted] with a possible witness identified as:

Detective [redacted] had previously spoken with Detective [redacted] who made him aware of content she located during searches of public online profiles. Detective [redacted] located on Facebook.com, a post associated with [redacted]. In the post, [redacted] claimed to be a witness to the incident and claimed to reside in the Canfield Green Apartment Complex.

Detective [redacted] contacted a representative of the Canfield Green Apartment Complex leasing office via telephone and requested a contact telephone number for [redacted]. Detective [redacted] was provided a phone number of [redacted] for [redacted].

At approximately 1:00 p.m., Detective [redacted] called the phone number of [redacted] in an attempt to speak with [redacted]. [redacted] answered and verified his personal identifying information. Detective [redacted] requested to meet with [redacted] in person for an interview. [redacted] immediately stated he did not witness anything related to the incident and was inside his apartment at [redacted] when the incident occurred; however, he would meet Detective [redacted] for an interview. Detective [redacted] advised [redacted] he would contact him at a later date to schedule an interview.

At approximately 4:00 p.m., Detective [redacted] drove to the Ferguson Police Department and met with Sergeant [redacted] of the Ferguson Police Department in order to obtain items previously requested by Detective [redacted]. Included was a request for a complete copy of radio transmissions from the Ferguson Police Department's main radio between 11:45 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. on Saturday, August 9, 2014. Sergeant [redacted] provided Detective [redacted] with the following items:

- Four DVDs containing Ferguson Police Department radio traffic on August 9, 2014 from 11:46 a.m. through 8:29 p.m.
- Ferguson Police Department interior and exterior closed circuit video surveillance on August 9, 2014 from 12:05 p.m. through 8:05 p.m.
- One DVD containing Ferguson Police Department 911 phone calls and radio traffic on August 9, 2014
- Printed out Ferguson Police Department event report #14-029058 for "SICK CASE" occurring at Glenark Drive on August 9, 2014
- Printed out Ferguson Police Department event report #14-029060 for "STEALING/IN PROGRESS" occurring at 9101 West Florissant Avenue on August 9, 2014

Detective [redacted] seized all above items as evidence and forwarded them to the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit.

Detective [redacted] then viewed copies of the above evidence to verify their content. After reviewing the radio traffic, Detective [redacted] noted the first DVD contained tracks 323-395 and 397-477. The second DVD contained tracks 478-516 and 518-641. The third DVD contained tracks 642-782. The fourth disc contained tracks 783-895. After reviewing the DVD containing 911 calls and radio traffic, Detective [redacted] noted the DVD contained two audio files associated with one 911 call from [redacted] Glenark Drive, one audio file for the 911 call from 9101 West Florissant Avenue and tracks 343-400 of radio traffic. Detective [redacted] contacted Sergeant [redacted] and advised him of the missing content. Sergeant [redacted] advised he would download the 911 radio traffic and contact Detective [redacted] when completed.
