Whereupon the Court grant her a license to reside in the State of Missouri during good behavior.

Sukey, a free woman of color, aged about thirty eight years five feet three inches high, dark complexion, comes and produces satisfactory evidence that she is of the class of persons of color who may be licensed to reside in this State, that she is of good character and capable of supporting herself by lawful employment, and enters into bond with security approved by the Court, conditioned for her good behavior during her residence in this State. Whereupon the Court grant her a license to reside in the State of Missouri during good behavior.

To Henry Bonghte for two 50/100 Dollars for hauling shingles to Co. farm.

To Jas. J. Purdy for 5 days attendance on a Committee with Justice Yeats and for twelve days attendance in Court to date for thirty four dollars.

To John Burk for twenty seven Dollars for nine coffins for the Poor house.

To Charles D. Drake for twenty five Dollars for examining the title of Kemper College, the County Farm and drawing deed from Richardson & Butler to the County.

To Wm. Harris for seven Dollars for Juror Certificate payable out of Jury fund.

To Elliott & Walker for ten 13/100 for linen for covers to the records in the Recorders office.

To Wm. E. Brush for six Dollars for a Juror Certificate payable out of the Jury fund.
