would not provide any personal identifying information over the phone. She said she would meet with detectives to provide a more detailed statement. She asked if Detective would call her at approximately 10:00 a.m., on Monday, August 11, 2014 to set up the interview.

At approximately 4:30 p.m., Detective met with Captain of the Ferguson Police Department. Captain drove to the Saint Louis County Police Department and hand delivered a manila envelope containing four CDs. The CDs included:

- 08-09-14 Radio Traffic (Tracks 369 through 400)
- 911 Calls from and a trooper reporting incident
- Ferguson Market 911 call
- 911 Call from

Accompanying the CDs were the Ferguson Police Department Duty Roster for August 9, 2014, a Ferguson Police Department Event Summary and a handwritten note with specific information from the phone call involving the phone number of

The CDs and paperwork were packaged as evidence and released to the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit.

Detectives later learned the radio traffic seized did not contain all of the radio traffic from the incident in question. A second request was made to the Ferguson Police Department.

**The following information documents the Saint Louis County Police Department’s investigative activities on Monday, August 11, 2014.**

At approximately 8:15 a.m., detectives met at the Saint Louis County Police Department’s Division of Criminal Investigation to assign tasks related to the investigation.

Detective of the Saint Louis County Police Department’s Division of Criminal Investigation, Bureau of Crimes Against Persons was directed to contact representatives of police departments that responded in the area around Ferguson in an attempt locate any possible video footage from patrol vehicles or officers that would have responded to P.O. Darren Wilson’s call for assistance. No video was located.

Detective of the Saint Louis County Police Department’s Division of Criminal Investigation, Bureau of Crimes Against Persons was directed to review internet footage from and attempt to contact . hosted a radio show in which he spoke with a possible witness, identified only as ” During interview with claimed to have witnessed the incident involving Michael Brown. The show could be found using the following link, ended the interview by saying he would contact because he had something to show him.

Using the email address [redacted] Detective [redacted] requested contact information for Detective [redacted] did not receive a response.

At approximately 10:45 a.m., Detective [redacted] received a phone call from Captain [redacted] of the Ferguson Police Department. Captain [redacted] indicated a male witness had driven to the Ferguson Police Department and wished to make a statement regarding what he saw take place on Canfield Drive. Captain [redacted] indicated the witness was willing to wait until a detective could meet with him.

At approximately 11:00 a.m., Detective [redacted] Detective Sergeant [redacted] Detective [redacted] of the Saint Louis County Police Department's Division of Criminal Investigation, Bureau of Crimes Against Persons and Sergeant [redacted], of the Saint Louis County Police Department's Division of Special Operations, MetroLink Detail, attempted to contact Dorian Johnson at his residence at Canfield Drive, Apartment [redacted] Detective [redacted] knocked on the apartment door but received no response.

[redacted] said [redacted] was currently employed at that [redacted] location. She said [redacted] boyfriend was Dorian Johnson. [redacted] was scheduled to work on August 11, 2014 at 11:00 a.m.; however, before the shift began, [redacted] called and spoke to [redacted] said she would not be attending work because she and Johnson were in "protective custody" relative to the incident in question. [redacted] said [redacted] did not elaborate as to who had taken them into protective custody. [redacted] did not provide [redacted] with updated [redacted]

contact information relative to her new location. [redacted] provided contact information on Johnson from [redacted] employee file. This contact information was consistent with the contact information previously known by detectives. [redacted] said she would contact detectives if she learned of any further contact information.

This concluded the conversation with [redacted]

Continuing attempts to contact Johnson, Detective [redacted] Detective [redacted] Detective [redacted] and Detective [redacted] traveled to [redacted]. This address was a previous listed home address for Johnson through a law enforcement computer check. After arriving at approximately 2:00 p.m., the four apartment structure was found to be vacant and abandoned.

Detective [redacted] spoke to a female who was sitting in a passenger car across the street. The female identified herself as:

[redacted] said she knew Dorian Johnson and he had last lived at the address approximately 6 months prior, but his sister still came to the neighborhood to see a male friend. Detective [redacted] informed her he was looking for Johnson as a witness. [redacted] male companion, who was unidentified and sitting in the passenger seat, said Johnson was in protective custody with the NAACP. Detective [redacted] asked him how he knew that; he said, "word on the street."

This concluded the conversation with [redacted] and her companion.

At approximately 6:00 p.m., Detective [redacted] contacted the Canfield Green Apartment [redacted] by phone. Detective [redacted] asked about any video cameras on the property. [redacted] confirmed there were no exterior cameras in the complex and stated the only camera on the property was located in the complex laundry facility. The camera faced inward and recorded activity inside the room to document any potential damage to the complex laundry machines.

At approximately 6:00 p.m., Detective [redacted] of the Saint Louis County Police Department's Bureau of Crimes Against Persons, attempted to make contact with the residents of [redacted] Canfield Drive where [redacted] indicated he had been [redacted] when he witnessed the incident. Detective [redacted] located telephone numbers of [redacted] during a law enforcement computer search. Detective [redacted] did not receive an answer after attempting to make contact via the telephone numbers; however, he left a voice message requesting a return telephone call.

**The following information documents the Saint Louis County Police Department's investigative activities on Tuesday, August 12, 2014.**

Detective [redacted] received a telephone message to contact Illinois State Trooper [redacted] in reference to the investigation.

Detective [redacted] spoke by phone with Trooper [redacted] who stated he received a phone call from an acquaintance asking for advice about what to do with information relating to the incident in question. He identified the acquaintance as:

[redacted] was an employee of DePaul Hospital. Trooper [redacted] requested Detective [redacted] contact [redacted] who had information about someone who offered to show her actual footage of the shooting.

Detective [redacted] contacted [redacted] and indicated he was calling to inquire about information she wished to provide to the police.

[redacted] said on August 12, 2014, while she was at work, she found herself locked out of her office. She contacted maintenance and requested they assist her with providing access into her office. While making entry into her office, the maintenance person, whom she identified as [redacted], began talking about the shooting involving Michael Brown. [redacted] told her he witnessed the entire event and said he recorded video on his mobile phone which proved what happened. [redacted] asked her if she wanted to see it. She declined to view the footage. [redacted] reached out to Trooper [redacted] for advice on what to do about the footage.

[redacted] said [redacted] worked in the maintenance department at DePaul Hospital and normally worked between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. She added he lived in the Canfield Green Apartments and said he saw the entire incident from his apartment.

Detective [redacted] then contacted a representative of [redacted] and requested assistance in locating any residents who worked at DePaul Hospital with the name of [redacted]. The representative indicated [redacted] resided in the complex and worked at DePaul Hospital.

At approximately 10:00 a.m., Detective [redacted] attempted to contact the daughter of [redacted] by phone. The call immediately went to voicemail. Detective [redacted] left a message for her to call return the call.

Detective [redacted] called and spoke with [redacted] by phone. [redacted] agreed to meet on August 13, 2014 at 9:30 a.m.

Detective [redacted] contacted [redacted] by phone and requested she have her husband contact Detective [redacted].

At approximately 11:10 a.m., Chief Criminal Investigator [redacted] of the Saint Louis County Prosecuting Attorney's Office received a phone call from a male who later identified himself as:

[redacted] indicated he wished to provide information about the incident in question. Investigator [redacted] asked to call [redacted] back momentarily and [redacted] agreed. Investigator [redacted] started a digital recorder and called [redacted].

Detective [redacted] presented P.O. Darren Wilson with a Christian Hospital Medical Records release form which he and his attorney signed, authorizing the release of his medical records. This form was later hand delivered to Christian Hospital employee [redacted] at approximately 1:00 p.m. [redacted] indicated the records were unavailable at that time.

At approximately 12:02 p.m., Detective [redacted] and Detective [redacted] of the Saint Louis County Police Department's Division of Criminal Investigation, Bureau of Crimes Against Persons arrived at the Ferguson Police Department to conduct follow-up, recorded interviews with P.O. [redacted] and P.O. [redacted] of the Ferguson Police Department. P.O. [redacted] and P.O. [redacted] had been identified as the first two police officers to arrive at the scene immediately after the incident in question.

**The following information documents the Saint Louis County Police Department's investigative activities on Wednesday, August 13, 2014.**

The United States Department of Justice and Federal Bureau of Investigation had previously indicated they were opening a civil rights investigation into the incident and planned to conduct an independent, but parallel investigation with the Saint Louis County Police Department's homicide investigation. Detective Sergeant \_\_\_\_\_ and Detective \_\_\_\_\_ met with Special Agent \_\_\_\_\_ and Special Agent \_\_\_\_\_ both of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

At approximately 9:00 a.m., Detective \_\_\_\_\_ called \_\_\_\_\_ on her telephone at \_\_\_\_\_. The call went to her voicemail and Detective \_\_\_\_\_ left a message informing her he was en route to her residence. said the business was equipped with several exterior video surveillance cameras, one of which was focused on the drive-thru located on the south side of the building.

Detective requested video surveillance footage from 11:00 a.m. through 12:30 p.m. on August 9, 2014. provided the footage on a CD.

Detective later packaged the video footage on CD as evidence and released it to the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit.

Detective attempted to make contact with an employee at West Florissant Avenue, a business identified as . She spoke with:

said the business was equipped with an interior camera that faced the front door and captured a portion of the parking lot. was unfamiliar with how to operate the system. Detective later requested Detective retrieve the video.

Detective attempted to make contact with an employee at West Florissant Avenue, a business identified as . She spoke with:

Thai said the business was not equipped with video surveillance cameras.

Detective attempted to make contact with an employee at West Florissant Avenue, a business identified as . She spoke with:

said the business was equipped with video surveillance cameras; however, they had been destroyed during the rioting on Sunday, August 10, 2014.

Detective [redacted] attempted to make contact with an employee at [redacted] West Florissant Avenue, a business identified as [redacted]. She spoke with:

[redacted] said the business was equipped with surveillance cameras; however, a loss prevention associate would have to retrieve the video. Detective [redacted] was unable to make contact with a loss prevention associate. Detective [redacted] later returned to the store where she contacted employee, [redacted] who allowed her to view the video system. After doing so, Detective [redacted] determined there were no cameras that provided a view of the parking area or West Florissant Avenue.

Detective [redacted] attempted to make contact with an employee at [redacted] West Florissant Avenue, a business identified as [redacted]. She spoke with a male who would only identify himself as [redacted]. [redacted] said the business was equipped with video surveillance cameras; however, they were not functioning.

Detective [redacted] attempted to make contact with an employee at [redacted] West Florissant Avenue, a business identified as [redacted]. She spoke with:

said the business was equipped with video surveillance cameras; however, they were only located inside the business.

Detective [redacted] attempted to make contact with an employee at [redacted] West Florissant Avenue, a business identified as [redacted]. She spoke with: [redacted]

Detective [redacted] attempted to make contact with an employee at [redacted] West Florissant Avenue, a business identified as [redacted]. She spoke with:

[redacted] said there were several interior security cameras. Detective [redacted] asked about a camera positioned near the front door. [redacted] stated it did not capture anything outside of the business.

Detective [redacted] also conducted a canvass of the area. The following are the results of his canvass.

Detective [redacted] was contacted by Property Maintenance Worker:

[redacted] stated he maintained the buildings with taxing addresses of [redacted] West Florissant Avenue, [redacted] West Florissant Avenue and [redacted] West Florissant Avenue. These buildings were all leased by numerous businesses and had additional addresses associated with the buildings. The three buildings were all owned by his employer:

[redacted] stated none of the businesses at [redacted] West Florissant Avenue had exterior cameras.

stated the building at West Florissant Avenue had one business with an internal camera facing West Florissant Avenue. He identified the business as . stated no businesses in that building had any external cameras facing West Florissant Avenue.

stated the building at West Florissant Avenue only had one operating business which was a doctor's office. He said the doctor's office did have a camera system. Detective walked around West Florissant Avenue and confirmed there were exterior cameras operated by Detective entered the doctor's office and contacted:

directed Detective to the camera system inside the office, where a live feed was playing on a monitor. One camera was on the front exterior of the building facing West Florissant Avenue and appeared to capture a portion of the roadway and sidewalks on West Florissant Avenue. was not familiar with the surveillance system but identified an employee who was familiar with the system:

stated was not working, but would be working on August 14, 2014. While at the business, Detective spoke to via telephone and confirmed she knew how to operate the camera system. However, she was unable to travel to the business due to an appointment later that day. stated she would be at the business the following day.

Detective attempted to make contact with an employee at West Florissant Avenue, a business identified as He spoke with:

After entering the business office, Detective [redacted] saw a monitor with a live feed of the business's video system. One of the cameras was pointed toward the intersection of West Florissant Avenue and Canfield Drive. The intersection was only partially visible and at a distance.

[redacted] was not immediately familiar with the video system. [redacted] further indicated [redacted] had a separate location to the south, and on the opposite side of West Florissant Avenue. This other location had a separate video surveillance system. This second location had an address of [redacted] West Florissant Avenue. Detective [redacted] requested video surveillance footage from 11:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. from both locations. [redacted] stated she would attempt to make copies of the footage the following day.

Detective [redacted] attempted to make contact with an employee at [redacted] West Florissant Avenue, a business identified as [redacted]. She spoke with:

[redacted] stated her parents, [redacted] and [redacted] owned the building at [redacted] West Florissant Avenue. The building rented space to [redacted] with a business phone number of [redacted].

[redacted] stated [redacted] did not have any cameras. The cameras on the exterior of the building were owned and operated by [redacted] was not able to immediately access the camera system, but stated she would contact the security company for instructions on how to download video footage.

In addition to the building at [redacted] West Florissant Avenue [redacted] stated her parents owned the building at [redacted] West Florissant Avenue which was undergoing renovations but did have a functioning security system. [redacted] stated she was also not familiar with how to review or download video footage from that system, and would contact the security company for further instructions.
