At approximately 3:25 p.m., Detective _____ of the Saint Louis County Police Department's Division of Criminal Investigation, Bureau of Crimes Against Persons arrived in the _____ block of Canfield Drive and contacted Detective _____.

Detective [redacted] was directed by Detective [redacted] to contact a female who was with Police Officer [redacted], of the Saint Louis County Police Department's, Division of Patrol, City of Jennings Detail. P.O. [redacted] was stationed near [redacted] Canfield Court for crowd control.

Detective [redacted] met with:

[redacted] identified herself as Michael Brown's grandmother. She said a male had previously approached her saying he had witnessed the incident. The male wrote [redacted] and [redacted] on a card and handed it to her, saying he would talk to the police and tell them what he saw. Detective [redacted] observed the card with the above handwritten information.

[redacted] went on to say she had been released from Christian Northeast Hospital at approximately 11:00 a.m., on Saturday, August 9, 2014. She was being driven to her home at [redacted] by her daughter, [redacted]. As they approached West Florissant Avenue and Canfield Drive, she saw Brown and a friend walking. She said [redacted] briefly stopped her vehicle next to them. Brown told them he would be right back and that he and his friend were going to the store. [redacted] and her daughter drove to her residence. A short time later, [redacted] said she was contacted by her other daughter, [redacted] identified as [redacted] informed her Brown had been shot.

6 more gunshots in rapid succession. When he was in a position to see what was occurring, he said he saw the victim lying on the street and a Ferguson police officer standing next to him. He said he did not see any other vehicles around the scene.

Detective contacted the following individual who, during the time of the canvass, was standing on the third floor stairway at Caddiefield Drive.

said she was sitting on the second floor stairway at Canfield when she heard subjects yelling. She could not understand what they were yelling. She heard what sounded like a gunshot, so she went into the second floor apartment on the left. She then heard what sounded like 5 gunshots in rapid succession. When she looked outside, she saw a black male with shoulder length dreadlocks with blonde tips wearing a red T-shirt, gray pants, and colorful Nike shoes. She said he ran to the west on Canfield Drive from the scene.

was asked several times if she witnessed or saw the shooting. She said she did not. She said she went into the apartment after the first shot. She would not provide any information on the people she was with. She said after the shooting had stopped, she saw the Ferguson police vehicle parked in the street, where it remained during the interview, and the deceased male lying on the street.

was unable to provide any additional information and the interview was concluded.

The canvass at Caddiefield Drive was concluded.

The canvass of the surrounding apartment buildings that would have potentially had a view of the incident taking place was concluded.

At approximately 3:36 p.m., Detective [redacted] was notified by the Saint Louis County Police Department's Bureau of Communications advising him that a male caller, who had identified himself as [redacted] had information about the incident and had video of the incident taking place. Detective [redacted] was provided a phone number of [redacted] and attempted to contact [redacted]. A male, who identified himself as [redacted] answered. [redacted] indicated his brother, [redacted] was in possession of his phone and had taken video of the incident. The call was ended after the male indicated his phone was about to die.

Detective [redacted] contacted the Bureau of Communications and learned the original call from [redacted] came from phone number [redacted].

Detective [redacted] later requested and received a CD containing the phone call from the Saint Louis County Police Department's Bureau of Communications. The CD was identified as Tapes 1 and 2. One track contained the phone call from [redacted] and the second track contained a phone call from a female caller who indicated the police officer involved in the incident had fled the scene. The CD was later packaged as evidence and released to the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit.

At approximately 5:15 p.m., Ferguson Police Department vehicle _____ was towed by Bolin Services from its location on Canfield Drive and was transported to the Saint Louis County Police Department Vehicle Processing Garage, located at 111 South Meramec Avenue, Clayton, Missouri 63105. Detective _____ followed the vehicle from the scene to the Vehicle Processing Garage.

At approximately 5:27 p.m., Detective _____ received another call from the Saint Louis County Police Department's Bureau of Communications who indicated another call was received from an unidentified male. The male indicated he witnessed the incident. The call came from a blocked number and was routed to Saint Louis County Police Department position T4. The male was still on the line and asked to be connected to a detective. Detective _____ was then connected to the unidentified male, via a 3-way call.

The male on the phone call indicated the police officer acted in self-defense; however, the caller was unwilling to meet and discuss the incident further or properly identify himself.

Detective _____ later requested and received a CD containing the phone call from the Saint Louis County Police Department's Bureau of Crimes Against Persons. This disc was identified as Tapes 3 and 4 and was later packaged as evidence and released to the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit.

Full details of the phone call can be heard on the associated CD.

After concluding the phone call, Detective _____ re-contacted the Bureau of Communications who indicated it appeared as though the phone call originated from _____

At approximately 5:45 p.m., Detective _____ was approached by a male who would not identify himself. The unidentified male indicated there was a male who was a witness to the incident standing with a group of individuals near the eastern end of the apartment complex.

As Detective _____ and Detective _____ were walking on Canfield Drive, outside the eastern end of the crime scene, attempting to locate the unknown witness, they walked by a parked vehicle occupied by an adult male and an adult female. The adult male in the driver's seat commented to detectives as they walked by that he witnessed the incident and the officer was, "in the right" and "did what he had to do." He added the statements being made by bystanders in the complex were inaccurate. The detectives momentarily stopped to speak with the male who was clearly uncomfortable speaking with detectives. The male indicated he was not making any further comments or identifying himself.

Detective _____ provided the male a business card and requested he call if he changed his mind about speaking with detectives. While walking away from the vehicle, Detective _____ noted the Missouri license plate of _____

Detective _____ spoke by phone to a male who identified himself as _____ indicated the first time he would be available to meet to discuss the incident was Sunday, August 10, 2014 at 7:00 a.m. Detective _____ directed Detective _____ to contact _____ and schedule an interview with him.

The investigation at the scene and associated interviews at or near the scene were concluded at approximately 7:00 p.m. The scene was released and detectives departed the area. Between the arrival of

detectives at approximately 1:30 p.m. and their departure at approximately 7:00 p.m., there was a continually increasing necessity for uniformed officers to respond to the area. The response was to aid in securing the scene and to address safety concerns with an increasingly volatile situation. Details of those events were documented under Saint Louis County Police Department Report Number 14-45038.

At approximately 6:00 p.m., Detective [redacted] arrived at 111 South Meramec Avenue in Clayton, Missouri 63105 where the Saint Louis County Police Vehicle Processing Garage was located and where Ferguson Police Department vehicle [redacted] had previously been towed for processing.

The following detectives from the Saint Louis County Police Department's Division of Criminal Investigation, Bureau of Criminal Identification, Crime Scene Unit, were also present at the garage:

During the investigation, a defect consistent with a bullet impact was found on the interior driver's door above the armrest. A bullet was recovered inside the driver's side door.

Detective [redacted] supplemental report can be viewed for additional details regarding his investigation.

After the vehicle was processed, Bolin Services arrived and towed the vehicle to the Ferguson Police Department.

This concluded the investigation at 111 South Meramec.

At approximately 8:00 p.m., Detective [redacted] arrived at the Saint Louis County Police Department's Bureau of Communications and seized a CD containing audio of his previous phone calls from Public Safety Dispatcher III, [redacted]

The CD was later packaged and marked as evidence and released to the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit.

After reviewing the calls, Detective [redacted] attempted numerous follow-up phone calls to the following numbers associated with each call:

No contact could be made with any of the phone numbers. A check of each phone number revealed the service provider for all three phones was T-Mobile, USA.

After returning to the Saint Louis County Police Department's Division of Criminal Investigation, Detective followed up on the Missouri license plate of The license plate was assigned to:

Detective directed Detective make an attempt to contact and schedule an interview.

At approximately 9:00 p.m., contacted Detective by phone. He indicated he had come in contact with two possible witnesses to the incident. advised he was attending a

While at the , he overheard a couple speaking about what they witnessed. said he urged the couple to speak with detectives and they hesitantly agreed.

Detective directed Detective and Detective to contact and arrange to meet with the witnesses.

Detective contacted via telephone. identified himself as:

advised he was still at the reunion, the witnesses were still available and they were willing to speak about what they witnessed.

At approximately 10:30 p.m., Detective [redacted] and Detective [redacted] arrived at [redacted] where they met with [redacted] introduced the detectives to witnesses:

and

Detective [redacted] and Detective [redacted] spoke with both [redacted] and [redacted] who said they were afraid to speak about what they witnessed. Both said they were worried about retaliation from people who live in the area. [redacted] said his [redacted] lives in the apartment complex and he is concerned for her safety. Detective [redacted] and Detective [redacted] advised [redacted] and [redacted] that their statements were important to the investigation and urged them to speak.

[redacted] began crying and said she could not talk about it.

[redacted] began speaking about what he observed. [redacted] said he and his wife pulled up to his residence. As they exited the vehicle, [redacted] observed a police vehicle parked in the roadway. [redacted] saw a large person, whom he could not further describe, standing beside the driver's door of the vehicle. [redacted] said the person had the upper portion of his body inside the driver's area of the vehicle. [redacted] said from his position, he could not hear any dialogue between the officer and the person. [redacted] said he continued toward his [redacted] residence. While at the door, [redacted] heard what sounded like a gunshot. [redacted] said he turned and observed a large black male facing toward an officer. [redacted] said the male began moving quickly toward the officer and he heard several more gunshots. [redacted] could not see if the male had anything in his hands and could not hear anything that was said. [redacted] said he immediately went inside his apartment.

[redacted] was unable to speak any further about what he witnessed and both were unwilling to provide recorded statements.

urged and to speak with detectives again at a later date. hesitantly agreed.

Detective and Detective concluded the interview.

At approximately 11:11 p.m., Detective and Detective drove to the Ferguson Market, located at 9101 West Florissant Avenue in Saint Louis, Missouri 63136. They were assisted by Police Officer and Police Officer both of the Saint Louis County Police Department's Division of Patrol, assigned to the City of Jennings Detail. After arriving, detectives made contact with the evening manager of the business:

Detectives asked if the business was equipped with video surveillance cameras. He stated it was. He led detectives to the back room of the business, where the video surveillance equipment was located. already knew the specific time and camera angles detectives were interested in, as he was aware of the incident that occurred in the store earlier that day. He immediately accessed footage from 08/09/2014 at 11:53 a.m. He directed the detectives' attention specifically to the footage from Camera #6, which faces from the front door of the business toward the front counter, and Camera #7, which faces from the back wall of the business toward the front doors.

Detective and Detective observed the footage which did not contain audio. According to the timestamp on the video, at approximately 11:53 a.m., two subjects entered the store. Detectives recognized one subject as Michael Brown. He was large in stature and dressed in a red Cardinals baseball cap, white T-shirt, khaki shorts, tall yellow socks, and sandals. The second subject was much shorter and thinner. He had shoulder length dreadlocks and was wearing a black T-shirt and shorts. This individual was later identified as Dorian Johnson. Although detectives did not know Johnson at the time, for clarity purposes, he will be identified as Johnson throughout the description of the video.

In the video, Brown walked directly to the front counter and reached behind the counter, out of view. He pulled his hand back and was holding what employees later identified as a box of cigarillos. He handed the item to Johnson and reached a second time behind the counter. He pulled an additional item out, which employees later identified as a smaller packet of cigarillos. In doing so, it appeared as if Brown got into a verbal dispute with the employee behind the counter. At that time, Johnson reached around Brown and placed the first box back on the counter. The employee stepped around the counter. The verbal dispute appeared to continue between the employee and Brown. The employee stood in the path of Brown and Johnson at the front doors of the business. Brown approached the employee and shoved him to the side,

causing him to stumble into a nearby shelf of products. Brown and Johnson then exited the business at approximately 11:54 a.m., with Brown still in possession of the second item taken from behind the counter.

identified the employee assaulted in the video as:

also identified as the owner of the business. was accompanied in the store at the time by who was also the store's typical morning manager:

identified the first item as a 60 count, box of Swisher Sweet brand cigarillos, regular flavor, valued at approximately \$33.99. He identified the second item as a 15 count, packet of Swisher Sweet brand cigarillos, regular flavor, valued at approximately \$15.00.

The first item which appeared to be placed back on the counter by Johnson, was recovered from inside the store.

was able to transfer the video surveillance footage of the incident to a USB memory drive. He included three additional outdoor views of the perimeter.

Detective asked if was injured in any way during the robbery. did not believe so.

could add nothing further and the interview was concluded.

Detective Detective P.O. , and P.O. departed the business.

Detective and Detective drove to the Ferguson Police Department. After arriving, they made contact with Captain Administrative Commander of the Ferguson Police Department. They advised him of the facts and circumstances of the incident at the Ferguson Market. Captain advised

them the Ferguson Market incident was previously documented under Ferguson Police Department Report Number 14-12388.

The video surveillance footage was downloaded and burned to a CD, which Detective [redacted] later packaged and marked as evidence and released to the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit.

During the late evening hours of Saturday, August 9, 2014, Detective [redacted] viewed online video footage from a local media outlet which showed an interview of a male who identified himself as Dorian Johnson. Johnson claimed he was with Brown when the incident took place. A computer search of Dorian Johnson was conducted which tentatively identified him as:

Dorian J. Johnson
Black Male

The following information documents the Saint Louis County Police Department's investigative activities on Sunday, August 10, 2014.

At approximately 7:40 a.m., Detective [redacted] attended the post-mortem examination of Brown at the Saint Louis County Medical Examiner's Office, located at 6039 Helen Avenue in Berkeley, Missouri 63134. Doctor [redacted] performed the examination.

Detective [redacted] and Detective [redacted] were present for the post-mortem examination and conducted their investigation. See Detective [redacted] supplemental report for additional details.

Before the examination began, Detective [redacted] observed Brown lying on his back on an examination table. He was wearing a gray short sleeve T-shirt, khaki shorts with a black belt over blue underwear and yellow socks with the outline of marijuana leaves on them. He had brown paper bags covering his hands and an identification bracelet on his ankle.

Brown had the tattoo "Big Mike" on his right forearm, "Dre" on his left forearm, and "Kelle" on his upper right arm.

During the external examination, Doctor [redacted] noted injuries consistent with gunshot wounds to the following areas on Brown's body:

Top of head
Forehead
Right side of chest
Right side of chest near the armpit

Through and through upper right arm
Through and through right forearm
Graze/Abrasion upper right arm
Right interior thumb

Doctor said the injury to the right thumb had a dark discoloration in and around the injury.

Brown had abrasions to the following locations:

Inside left forearm
Right hip
Left thumb
Left wrist
Right front shoulder
Forehead
Bottom lip

Doctor said Brown had damage caused by a bullet to his right eye and what looked like an exit wound on his right facial cheek.

During the internal examination, Doctor removed one bullet from Brown's head, one from his right lateral back, and one from his posterior right chest.

Detective seized the bullets, fingernail scrapings/clippings from Brown's left and right hands, swabs from left and right hands, a blood card, clothes, and brown paper bags.

Detective also seized a small baggie containing a green vegetative substance believed to be marijuana from Morgue Attendant advised it was discovered during an inventory of Brown's clothes prior to the examination beginning.

The post-mortem examination concluded at approximately 11:10 a.m.

During the interview with P.O. Darren Wilson, he made reference to a map. He was also presented photo lineup number 146113, in an effort to positively identify Dorian Johnson as the other individual present. Each of these items were later packaged as evidence and released to the Saint Louis County Property Control Unit.

The interview with P.O. Darren Wilson was completed at approximately 10:47 a.m.

At approximately 12:22 p.m., Detective [redacted] contacted Leslie McSpadden by phone. During a portion of the conversation, Detective Wilson requested she assist in contacting Dorian Johnson and explain to him the importance of speaking with detectives. She indicated she would do so if she came in contact with him; however, she had had no contact information for him.

At approximately 2:40 p.m., Detective [redacted] was contacted by the Saint Louis County Police Department's Bureau of Communications and made aware of a female caller who identified herself as [redacted] said she witnessed the incident and would like to talk to a detective. Her phone number was [redacted]

At approximately 2:45 p.m., Detective [redacted] called the phone number [redacted]. A female answered and identified herself only as, [redacted]. She provided the following information.

[redacted] said she was driving [redacted] on the Canfield Green Apartment Complex. She turned off West Florissant Avenue onto Canfield Drive and headed toward the apartment complex. When she rounded the bend near the front of the apartment complex, she heard what sounded like two gunshots. She said she stopped her vehicle approximately one block west of the police car which she described as a car not a SUV. She saw a black male with his arms extended out as if he were holding something near the driver's door of the police car. She said the black male ran toward the back of the police car. The officer exited the driver's door and ran toward the subject with his gun drawn and at his side. She could hear the officer yell, "Down, Down!" The subject stopped and turned toward the officer. He put his hands in the air for approximately 1 – 2 seconds. He dropped his arms and ran toward the officer. She said the officer took a step to the side and shot at the subject. She said the subject kept coming toward the officer and began to fall and stumble. She said the officer stopped shooting at the subject once he fell to the ground on his stomach.
